DIVISIONS

KATA: (Age as on August 17, 2024) White-Orange

Green-Purple Red - Black

WEAPON KATA

Under 10; 11 to 15; 16 to 20; 21 to 25; 26 to 34; +35; +45 +50.(male and female will be separate unless there's too little in a division), Long (Bo, Ecko) & short will be separated. Novice Kobudo students may perform part of a kata also, i.e. 14 moves.

<u>KUMITE</u>

Same age and belt groups as kata. Divisions will be combined if there are two or less competitors per division.

<u>NOTE!</u>

If you have black belts who can assist with judging on the day, it would be appreciated. (You may officiate in your gi) Non contesting judges please wear referee attire!

GENERAL CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

1. GENERAL RULES

- Should any tournament rules / arrangements be disregarded, the offending person / participant or spectator may be required to leave the championship / venue, immediately.
- Participants take part at their own risk. No claim may be made against the host Shorin-Ryu Tigers or any of the officials officiating on the day of the tournament.
- It is the responsibility of each instructor to explain the conditions to the participant before entering the championship.
- Karateka must participate in white Gi's (Karate suits)
- Only the official application form will be accepted, legibly completed.
- We reserve the right to combine divisions where only one or two entries are received.
- No entry fees will be refunded on withdrawal.
- Only the official coaches will be allowed on the floor.
- The 6 point rule for kumite and scoring boards for kata will be applicable.
- The division for entries are detailed in the attached invitation and Championship Rules.
- No late entries will be accepted after the closing date (07/08/2024). No exception or privileges will be granted.
- Any participant not reporting to his/her floor after 3 call-out's, will be immediately disqualified.

2. OFFICIALS

- A meeting will be held at 07h00 on the day at the hall, whereby all referees, managers, coaches, instructors and table officials will be briefed regarding the rules and arrangement concerning the championship.
- Referees and judges may officiate in a gi if they partake, other officials or team managers should, wherever possible, wear grey / black trouser, white shirt, tie and blazer.
- Female officials or team managers should, wherever possible wear grey / black skirt or trousers, white blouse and blazer.

3. KATA RULES

 Participants will be restricted to performing approved traditional kata from their Style only. The kata performed should be in line with the contestant's current grade! Red to black belt divisions will do two different kata and the two scores will be combined to determine the winners.

4. KUMITE RULES

- Hand and mouth protection is compulsory when participating.
- Chest protectors are optional for female participants (please note that chest protectors may only protect the chest and not the stomach).
- Red or white mitts will be allowed.
- The 6 point rule will be applied for students 14 and older with a knock out draw sheet, no negative point will be given. The 4 point rule will be applied for students 13 and younger with a repechage draw sheet, no negative points will be given.
- Only the appointed coach from each team may coach a participant while preparing for a fight. COACHING WILL BE ALLOWED WHILST A FIGHT IS IN PROGRESS AS LONG AS IT IS DONE FROM THE COACHING CHAIR!

5. SPECTATORS

- No spectator or supporter may move onto or interfere in the arena.
- On the day of the tournament no arguments with a referee will be permitted. Should there be a problem on the floor, it can be resolved by reporting it to the relevant floor manager, who will bring it to the attention of the tournament director. Formal complaints can be presented in writing and the tournament director will give feedback.
